- **Office spaces, coworking, showrooms and common areas** to **foster innovation and collaboration**

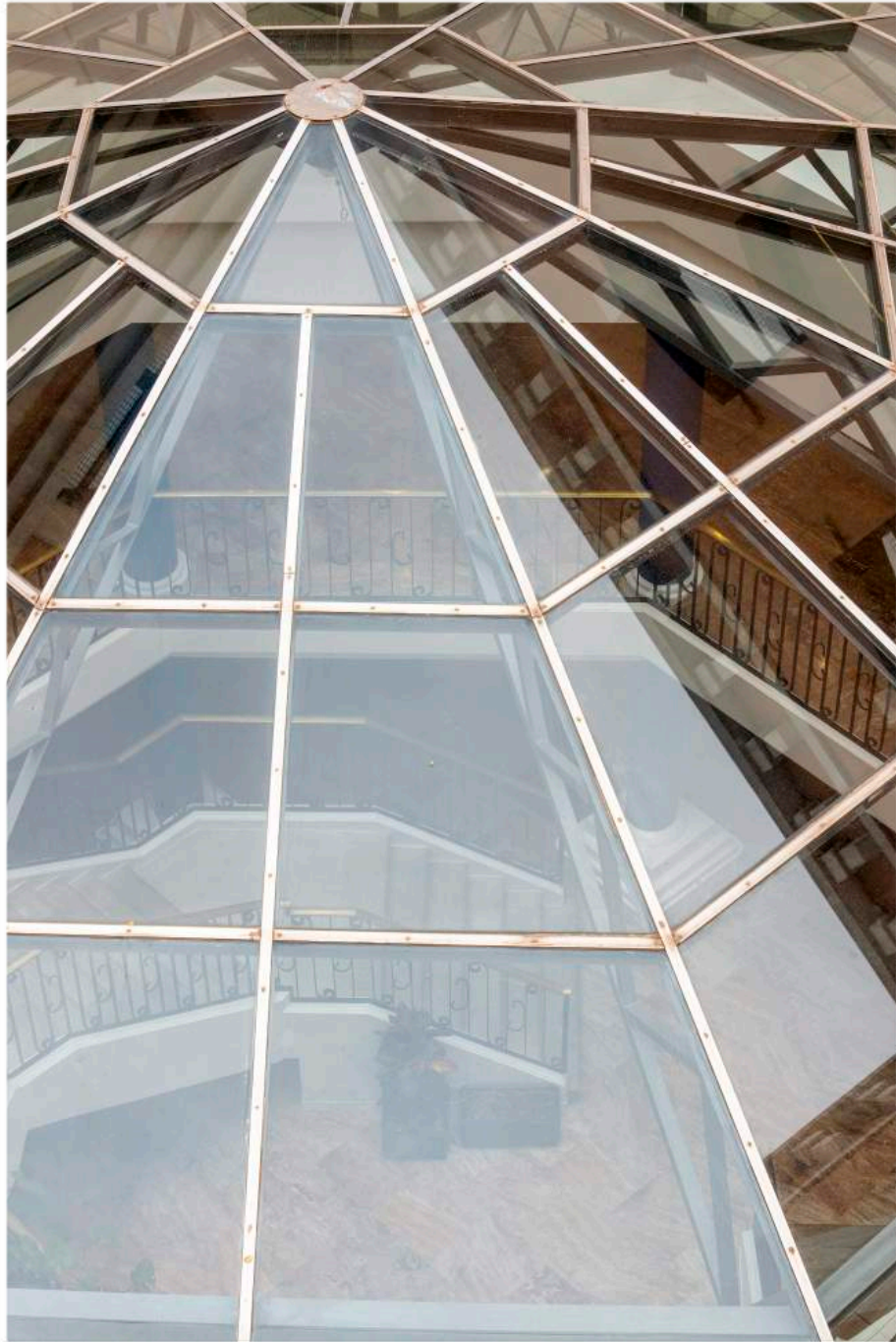


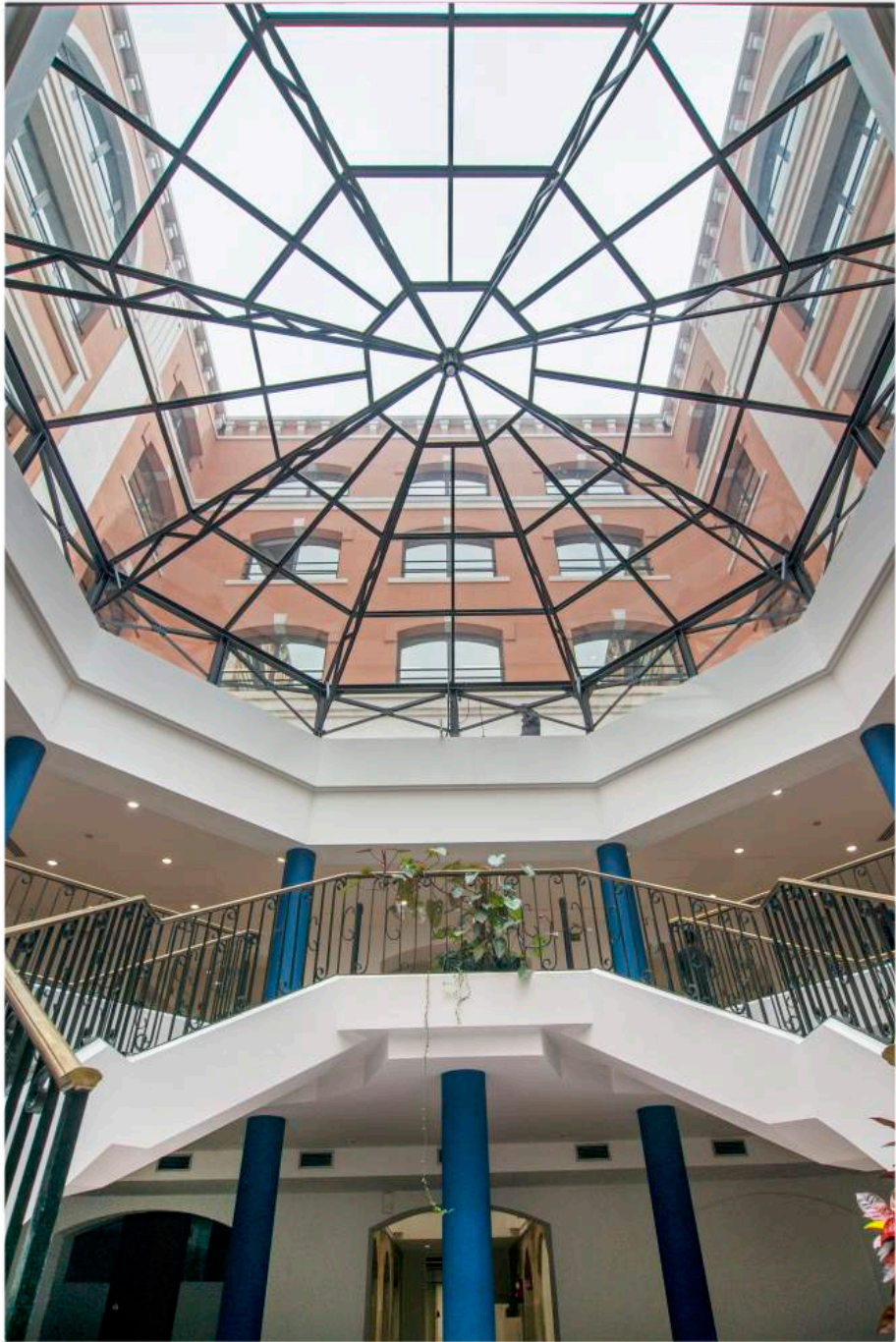

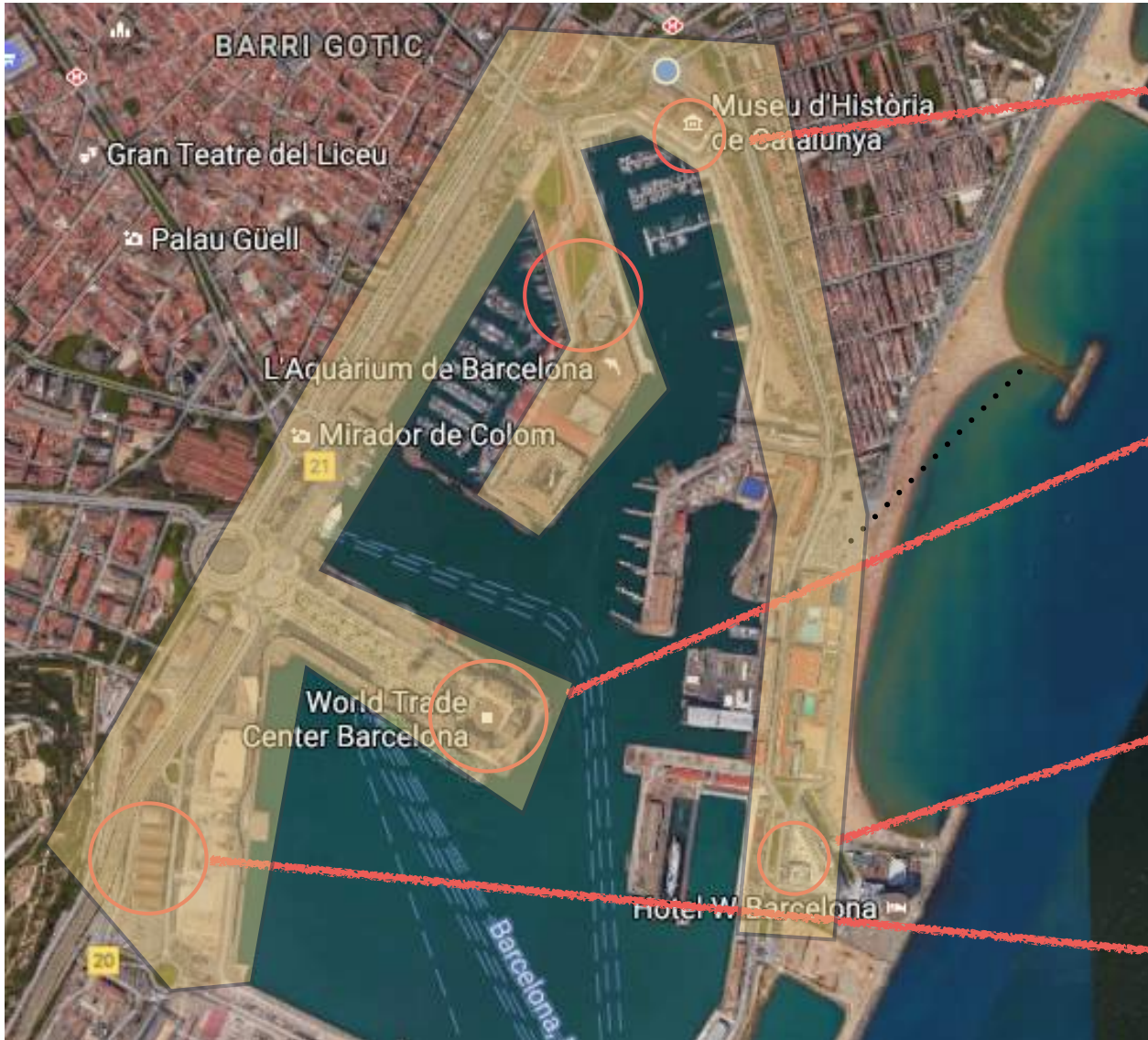
