He graduated in Civil Engineering from the Universidad Politécnica in Madrid (1981) and obtained an MBA from MIT Sloan School of Management (1986). He was CEO of Grupo Ferrovial from 1992 to 1999, when he was appointed Executive Vice Chairman.

He is currently Executive Chairman of Ferrovial, Chairman of the Board of Cintra and member of the Board of Banesto, of Blackstone International Advisory Board and of the Advisory Board of Spain's Confederation of Employers (CEOE).

Rafael del Pino maintains contact with the academic world through membership of the MIT Sloan School of Management Dean's Advisory Council, the MIT Energy Initiative's External Advisory Board and an MIT Corporation Visiting Committee. He is also a member of the International Advisory Board of IESE and of Harvard Business School European Advisory Board.

He was named a Global Leader for Tomorrow by the World Economic Forum and is a former member of the Board of Uralita and of the Boards of Círculo de Empresarios and Spain's Family Enterprise Institute.
