The admissions process operates on a rolling basis. All applicants are encouraged to submit a completed application in the early rounds, with the understanding that the Global Executive MBA's dynamic classroom experience calls for the right mix of participants with professional maturity, international diversity and a wide range of perspectives. Offers will be extended based on the applicant's merit, while paying strict attention to the unique contribution that the candidate is able to offer the group.

Before applying, we encourage you to contact us. You will be assigned an Admissions Mentor, who will review your CV at the early stages of your information-gathering process and help you evaluate how well the program suits your needs.

Admitted students can defer their program participation for up to one year in either of the two formats, Bimonthly / Monthly, until the next start date.

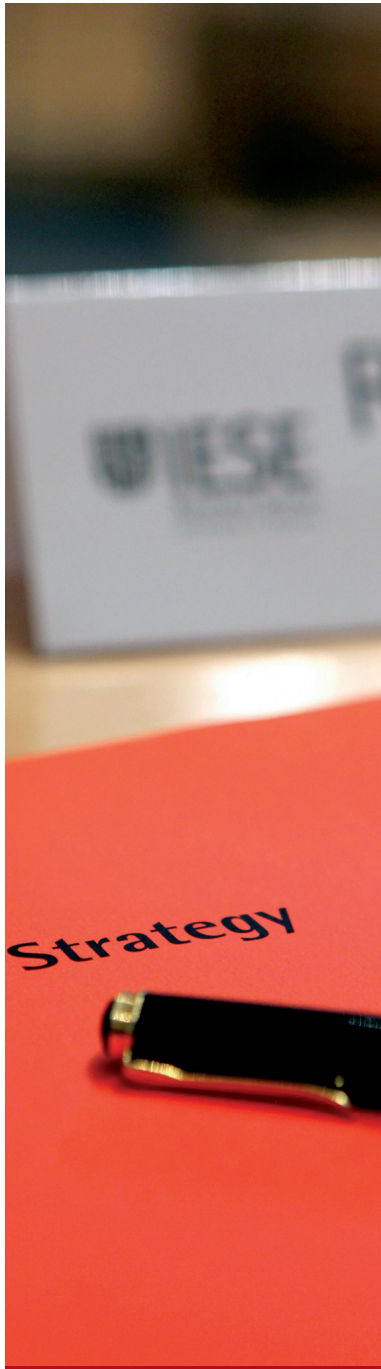
- A minimum of 10 years of work experience, with relevant managerial experience

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- **Completed online application**
- **Two letters of recommendation:** We encourage candidates' recommenders to make use of the online recommendation form through the Embark application. One recommendation must come from a current immediate supervisor. The second letter may come from a past or present employer, client/customer, etc.
- **University transcripts:** You must submit one original transcript from each institution from which you have been awarded a degree. Transcripts should reflect course work, results and degree awarded. Certified translations are required for transcripts in a language other than English.
- **Letter of company support** indicating that your employer understands the time commitment and travel necessary to complete the program.
- Clear copy of **current valid passport**.
- One **digital photograph**.
- **GMAT Score:** Scores should be sent directly to IESE Business School. The school code is 7099. GMAT can be waived for applicants with 15 years of experience or more, depending on background and experience. GMAT waivers will be strictly evaluated by the Admissions Committee on one to one basis.

- **English Language Test:** Required for all candidates who are not native English speakers. The requirement may be waived for those with a minimum of 2 years of professional experience in an English-speaking country.
- **A \$130 non-refundable application fee,** payable upon submission of online application.
