

Josep Valor has served as Professor of Information Systems at IESE in Barcelona since 1985 and as Director of Scientific Personnel and Research since 2006. From 2000-2004 served as Director of the PwC&IESE e-Business Center.

Earned Doctorate in Industrial Engineering from the Polytechnic University of Catalonia, Ph.D. in Operations Research from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), and Sc.D. in Medical Engineering from the Harvard-MIT Division of Health Sciences and Technology (HST). Has authored numerous articles and co-written five books on information systems and process innovation, the most recent of which include "Sources of Information Value" (Palgrave MacMillan, 2004) and "Los Sistemas de Información en la empresa actual" (McGraw-Hill, 2006).

Professor Valor complements his academic activities by providing IT management consulting, where he has assisted numerous companies with issues related to investments and developing competitive advantages based on information technologies. In 1998, he served as coordinator of the advisory group that produced the *Recommendations for Information Society Industries* for the Spanish Ministry of Industry, and in 2003 served as editorial coordinator for the document entitled *Reflection on the Information Society* for the Catalan autonomous government.

During the 1992-93 and 1996-97 school years, was visiting professor at the MIT Sloan School of Management where in addition to developing research topics, he taught courses on strategy and information technology for the Master's program.
