This year, Prof. Vives has started a new position as the Director of the IESE Banking Initiative. The IESE banking initiative, with the support of Citi, wishes to study post-crisis developments of banking and financial markets, paying particular attention to regulation and competition policy and the impact on business banking models. The initiative aims to promote a rigorous and informed dialogue on current issues in the fields of banking and financial markets among academics, regulators, companies and civil society.

The first report (of three) from the IESE Banking Initiative was launch in Spring 2019, focus on the regulation of the financial market in the last decade: "Sound at last? Assessing a Decade of Financial Regulation".





As in the past years, IESE PPSRC and ROCHE have organized the Innovative Healthcare strategies seminars, where a keynote speaker is invited to present a topic, such as Fundraising in health sector or health systems in Europe. The seminars are an exclusive event for CEOs from top hospitals in Catalonia and Valencia region, based on the Chatham house rules.







GrowSmarter

During the 2018-2019 Academic Year, PPP for Cities kept working in the H2020 European Project, GrowSmarter. PPP for Cities activity was focus on assessing the financial and economic sustainability of the 50 Smart solutions implemented in Barcelona, Cologne and Stockholm. Last version of the report will be presented in October 2019, and the insights show how some Smart solutions are financially sustainable, without help from the Public Sector, while others need a public support that can be justify considering their positive externalities (emission savings).

The economic impact of Bike Sharing

The report examines both the economic performance of 13 bikesharing initiatives in Europe, and new potential challenges arriving on the scene.

The authors studied these effects on bike-share programs in 13 European cities, all national or regional capitals -- Barcelona, Berlin, Bilbao, Cologne, Copenhagen, Hamburg, London, Madrid, Milan, Paris, San Sebastian, Turin and Vienna.


When measuring economic impact alone, it was ambiguous whether or not bike-share programs paid for themselves: the economic impact in the 13 cities studied was between 0.79 and 1.14 euros per euro spent.

The health benefits tipped the balance, however. Although there are dangers associated with increased bicycle use (accidents, inhaling more polluted air), these are, the authors state, "far from eclipsing the health benefits obtained thanks to the physical activity that bikesharing systems allow." Overall, the health benefits were the equivalent of preventing more than 90 premature deaths in the 13 cities between 2014 and 2016, representing 0.12 percent of estimated deaths of people under the age of 65 in those cities. There were corresponding savings in the health-care systems.



- Mobility As A Service.















