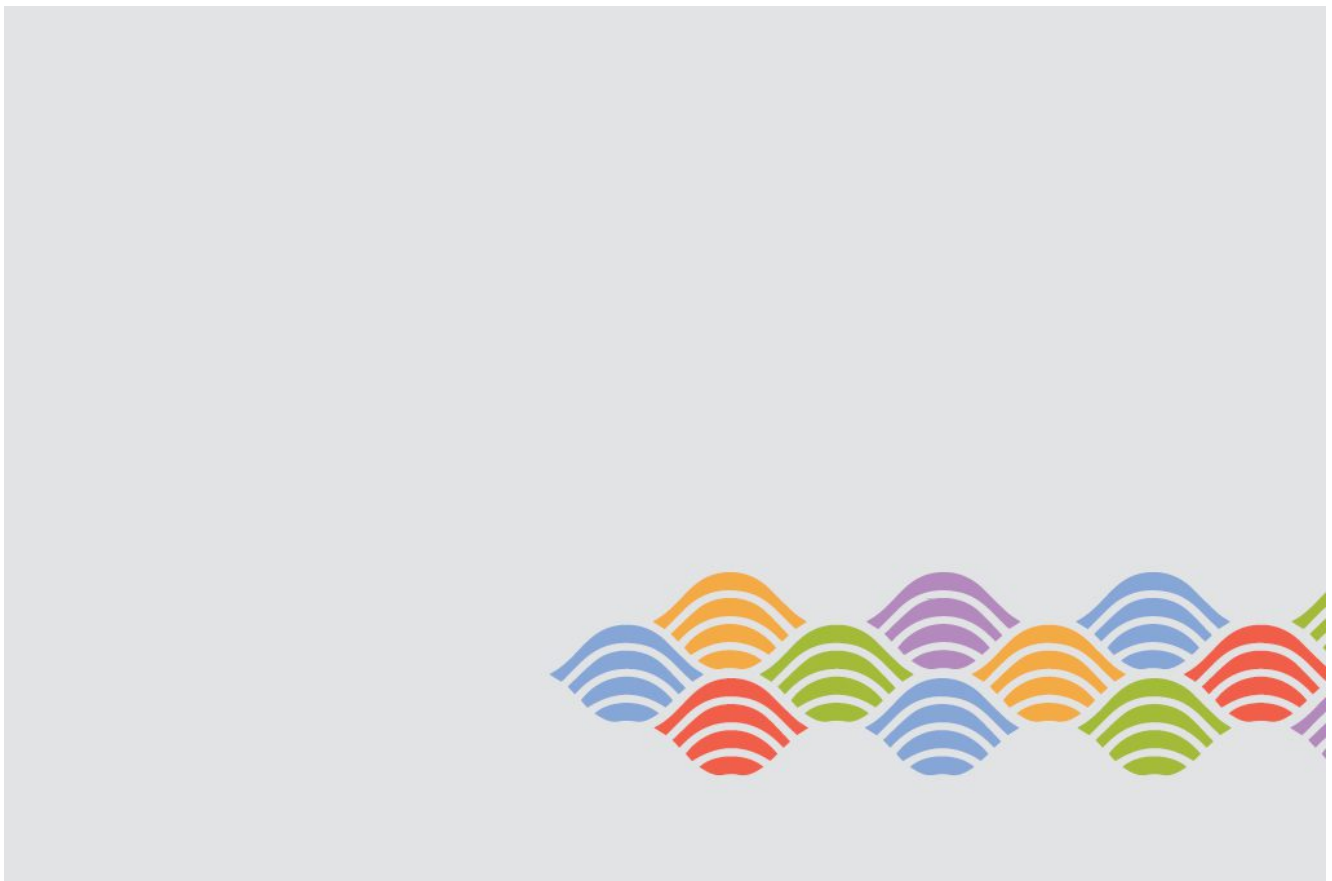


Leaping ahead: Lessons from Africa for making strides in business
