

2021 outlook: a K-shaped recovery, strong euro, cheap credit and five more things to watch

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In 2021, a K-shaped economic recovery is expected, meaning that some sectors will bounce back swiftly, while others may have changed forever, so their path back to health is expected to be slower. The good news is that recovery funds and low interest rates could make it a good time to invest and take risks in promising areas.
