Before coming to campus...



1. Get tested.

You'll need to get tested for coronavirus in the week before you come to campus, and you'll be required to input the results of that test into our health questionnaire to gain access to campus. It's important to start planning for your testing early, to give yourself enough time to receive the results. 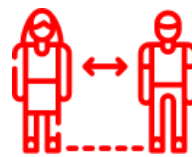
2. Complete the campus access questionnaire.

You must fill out the form before initially coming to campus, and at least once a week after that, in order to avoid retaking tests. The system will give you a QR code that you must present upon arrival. You can access the questionnaire at <https://health.iese.edu/>.

3. Temperature monitoring.

Your temperature will be taken when you arrive to campus. In the event that your temperature exceeds 37°C, you will not be allowed to access the campus.

4. Protect yourself with a mask and hygiene measures.

- Wear a mask in all campus areas. We recommend that you bring your own mask, but masks will be available at the entrance should you not have one.
- Use the disinfectant gel that you will find at reception and in common areas.
- Wash your hands often.

5. Maintain a safe social distance.

- Stay 2 meters apart when interacting with others.
- Respect occupancy guidelines. You'll see signs offering guidance on the number of people allowed in different spaces.
- Refrain from all physical contact during greetings.
- Do not share office supplies or other items.
